KWN Condemns Violence Occurring after Jan. 24 Protest

Kosova Women's Network (KWN) condemns the violence that occurred after Jan. 24 national protest organized by the association "Thirrjet e Nënave" (Mothers' Calls).

KWN demands from relevant institutions to:

1. Make public the names of persons who caused these acts of violence;
2. Persons responsible to be brought to justice and punished appropriately for the acts committed; and
3. The same people to be obliged by the law to pay material damages caused, so that these expenses are not charged to Kosovo taxpayers.

The Kosova Women's Network (KWN) supports, protects and promotes the rights and the interests of women and girls throughout Kosova, regardless of their political beliefs, religion, age, level of education, sexual orientation and ability. KWN fulfills its mission through the exchange of experience and information, partnership and networking, research, advocacy and service.
